Circa 1845. By Francis Thompson, designer of all the stations on the Chester to Holyhead Railway (opened 1848). Italianate 2 storey 5 bays entrance front with advanced outer bays. Dark red brick with painted freestone dressings and terracotta panels. Tall brick stacks with bracket cornices, moulded eaves with plain frieze, banded quoins, window architraves linked vertically with ornamental panels to outer bays. Panels contain a coronet over cartouche head with parchment scroll inscriptions (Lord Mostyn's arms?). Double hung sash and case windows with paired centre glazing bars (mostly gone), terracotta cartouche over lean-to metal canopy on scrolly fretwork brackets, double panelled doors under. Platform elevation has a straight 2 storey 5 window front with 1 storey pavilions at outer angles, long metal canopy with centre doorway and detailing as before.

### Group Value

The condition of the building at the time of inspection was derelict, with the roof mostly collapsed.
