Cira 1848, when the Chester to Holyhead Railway was opened. Possibly designed by Francis Thompson. One storey dark red brick goods shed with some freestone dressings, brick pediment treatment with apex chimneys to gables, slate roof. Plain end pilasters to long sides, parapets with coping and eaves band linked to pedimented gable ends. Triple blind arcades with stepped capitals to flanks, tall pairs of arched train openings to gables, all with brickwork arch rings.

W openings flank on one-storey extension with blocked oculus, E openings and heads of W openings now blocked, double boarded doors, lean-to hood to right hand opening. 3 out of 4 original timber trusses with massive tie-beams remain under top lit roof.

The condition of the building is derelict.
